

1 • Burning But Not Consumed

2 • Exodus 3:1-5

Now Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian, and he led his flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. And the angel of the LORD appeared to him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush. He looked, and behold, the bush was burning, yet it was not consumed. And Moses said, "I will turn aside to see this great sight, why the bush is not burned."

3 • Exodus 3:1-5

When the LORD saw that he turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then he said, "Do not come near; take your sandals off your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." (ESV)

4 • Moses' Story

- Born a Hebrew slave
- Rescued by Pharaoh's daughter
- Raised as an Egyptian prince
- Identifies with the Hebrews
- Commits murder and runs away
- Lives in exile for 40 years as a shepherd

5 • The Setting

- Burning bush
 - Not consumed
- Holy ground
 - Take off shoes

6 • The Call

- Go back to where you started
- Go back to the scene of the crime
- Go back and fight injustice
